INSTRUCTIONS waste collection



Treatment of masks, gloves and tissues

Masks, gloves and tissues must be kept on board for at least 24 hours in a dedicated bag, before being thrown in the grey bin of household waste.

<u>Caution</u> > It is strictly forbidden to dispose of this sanitary waste at sea, in the voluntary delivery bins, the yellow bins or any place not provided for this purpose.

Treatment of recyclable waste

On land, you will find bins to deposit your recyclable waste:

- Glass bin : only glass bottles, jars and pots.
- Terminal for packaging: only cans, beverage cans, aluminium trays and aerosols | Plastic bottles, cans and flasks | Cardboard cans, packaging and overpacks).

This waste must be deposited in bulk, bagless and empty.

Treatment of household/hazardous waste

This waste must be deposited in bulk, bagless and empty.

<u>Caution</u> > Your hazardous waste must be collected through specific channels:

- You are requested to use the containers dedicated to the collection of your batteries and oils (exclusively) provided by the Marina du Marin;
- Please, contact your distress flares supplier to drop off your used distress flares:
- Your other hazardous waste will have to be deposited in a waste collection area as soon as deconfinement allows it.
