## RULES APPLYING TO EU/EEA SAILORS

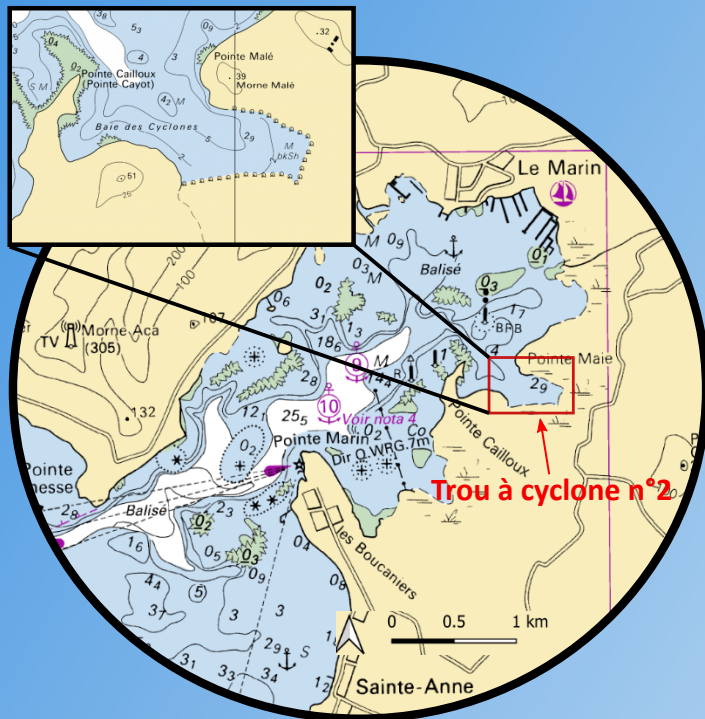
### HOW TO STOP OVER IN MARTINIQUE



Except for those coming from Martinique, Guadeloupe or Saint-Barthélemy, entry in territorial waters is conditioned upon proving from a **Covid-19 negative test performed less than 72 hours before arrival** for each passenger and/or crew member. **A declaration of entry must also be submitted to Fort-de-France MRCC 24 hours before arrival:**

Passengers who cannot justify from such tests must head to Le Marin's harbour (La Marina). **A sanitary test center has been deployed on site in order to facilitate Covid-19 screening tests.**



To perform a test, one must make an **appointment** with La Marina, before arrival:

*Specify : last name / first name / date of birth / phone no. / social security no. / date for the appointment*

During the wait for the results, the whole crew must stay isolated at anchor in the **cyclonic shelter n°2** (« trou à cyclone n°2 », as shown beside).

**Are exempted from the screening test obligation, passengers/crew members who:**

- are directly leaving Martinique by plane at the end of their navigation;
- have navigated without any stop during at least 7 days before arrival in Martinique, under condition to justify from a sworn statement arguing not to present Covid-19 infection symptoms.
